## **Rules, Terms & Conditions**

- 1. The Blas na hÉireann awards are open to food producers registered on the island of Ireland.
- 2. All entries must be produced on the island of Ireland.
- 3. Entries must be made by the producer.
- 4. All entries must be commercially available at the time of entry.
- 5. All entries must be of the exact standard as the same products available commercially. Please note that we do ask for details of at least one outlet where the products are commercially available and we do conduct mystery shopping on our entries.
- 6. All entries are tasted blind, and will be removed from packaging for tasting. The products must contain no identification marks (if applicable).
- 7. It is the responsibility of the entrant to ensure prompt and safe delivery of entries.
- 8. It is the responsibility of the entrant to ensure that all foods entered are packed, transported and delivered in a condition that makes them safe and fit for consumption.
- 9. While Blas na hÉireann will take great care to ensure safe keeping of all entries throughout the judging process, the organisers, serving team and associates cannot be held responsible for this safe keeping.
- 10. No entries will be returned to entrants.
- 11. Entry fees are not refundable.
- 12. Your fees paid includes your membership fees to the Blas na hEireann producers forum for 2014
- 13. No information relating to the identity of any of the judges will be revealed at any time.
- 14. All award winners will be announced at the awards ceremony and will also be announced online on <a href="https://www.irishfoodawards.com">www.irishfoodawards.com</a>
- 15. In all matters regarding the awards, the verdict of the judges is final.
- 16. Each entry must reach a minimum standard to proceed within the competition.
- 17. A minimum of 5 samples are to be delivered for each product
- 18. All products must be delivered in a suitable durable container with category labelling to appear on the container only.
- 19. Where the level of entries in a category is too low, categories can be combined at the discretion of Blas na hEireann. Where the level of entries is sufficient, subcategories may be created at the discretion of Blas na hEireann.

#### **Awards**

In addition to Gold, Bronze and Silver Medals in each of the following categories, there will be various other Awards including overall Supreme Champion & 'Best Artisan Product'\*, Chefs' Choice\*\* & New Product\*\*\*

<sup>\*</sup>Artisan producer – is a producer who hand makes in relatively small quantities / batches, not mass produced. Produced using local materials / resources / craft.

<sup>\*\*</sup>Chefs' Choice is based on products which would be used in the restaurant or catering trade.

<sup>\*\*\*</sup>New Products must be less than 12 months commercially available.
